



SWIMMING POOL RULES

- 1. The pool will normally be open for use from 11:00am to 8:00pm Monday – Sunday. No one will be allowed in the pool at other hours with the exception of supervised lesson hours as established by the Pool Manager. Hours may vary due to weather and season, special activities or maintenance. The Pool Manager or attendant is authorized to close the pool should, in his or her judgment, circumstances warrant.**
- 2. Residents and guests should be prepared to present resident cards or guest cards to the attendant.**
- 3. Guest coupon books are available for \$10.00 for five (5) coupons and a guest card must be presented at the time you bring a guest. Residents must accompany their guests and are responsible for their conduct. The same guest, other than out-of-town guests shall not be introduced more than five times in one month.**
- 4. Upon completion of an application form, members may purchase a weekly out-of-town guest card for \$10.00. Out-of-town guests, with the exception of dependants who do not reside with the members, must reside at least 25 miles outside Oldham County.**
- 5. Residents may purchase a season card for a babysitter or companion who is employed by the member for \$35.00.**
- 6. Young children under the age of ten (10) shall not be left at the pool area unattended. THIS RULE WILL BE RIGIDLY ENFORCED. If any doubt occurs as to a child's ability to swim, the attendant on duty may ask the child to leave and to be accompanied by a parent or adult on future visits.**
- 7. Dunking, wrestling, running or towel-flipping are NEVER PERMITTED and will result in disciplinary action being taken.**
- 8. Hard or water soaked balls, towels, hats, paper cups, popsicle sticks, plastic straws, chewing gum, etc. are NOT PERMITTED in the pool since they may endanger other swimmers and/or possibly cause damage to the filtration equipment.**
- 9. Plastic inflatable objects are acceptable as long as the use of these items is not dangerous and does not infringe upon the rights of others.**

- 10. Willful defacing or destruction of property WILL NOT BE TOLERATED and will be grounds for immediate suspension of pool privileges. Residents will be liable for loss or damages caused by them or their guests.**
- 11. The pool is regularly inspected by representatives of the Oldham County Board of Health, who give a rating for cleanliness and hygienic conditions after each inspection. Accordingly, residents are urged to exercise the utmost care in disposing of their cigarettes and other refuse matter. Nothing should ever be thrown into the pool. Glass containers are PROHIBITED within the fenced area.**
- 12. Pool deck furniture is not to be moved outside the fenced pool area.**
- 13. Pets are PROHIBITED except for seeing-eye dogs.**
- 14. The Club is not responsible for lost articles, accidents or injury to members or guests using the facilities. All personal possessions are to be removed from the pool and dressing areas at the end of each day.**
- 15. Residents are fully responsible for the conduct of their children and guests while on Clubhouse premises. Failure to cooperate will result in suspension of the member from the use of all Clubhouse facilities.**
- 16. In furtherance of the safety and welfare of all persons using the pool, the attendant is authorized to discipline the children of residents. Disciplinary measures will range from a verbal warning to loss of pool privileges.**
- 17. Proper swimming attire must be worn. No blue jeans or tee-shirts allowed in pool.**
- 18. Use of the facility by entering the clubhouse, pool and tennis court properties during times other than normal operating hours or reserved hours, by any persons not entitled to use the facilities, shall be considered trespassing and treated accordingly.**
- 19. Use of radios, CD players, MP3 players and tape players is restricted to the portable type with headphones. Playing of loud music is PROHIBITED.**
- 20. Pool lounge chairs are available on a first come first serve basis. Reserving chairs for persons that are not on the pool premises is PROHIBITED.**
- 21. All accidents, however minor, are to be reported to the attendant on duty.**
- 22. Diving into shallow water is PROHIBITED.**
- 23. Smoking is PROHIBITED inside the pool area.**
